2020 AP Exams

- Exams will NOT be administered face-to-face
- Students will take 45-minute Free Response ONLY exams
- Students will be offered two dates to choose from for each exam
- The exam schedule will be available APRIL 3, 2020
- Exams will be supported via computer, tablet, or smartphone. **Taking photos of written work will also be an option.**
