

**PROPORTIONATE SHARE / EQUITABLE SERVICES
INFORMATIONAL MEETING FOR FAMILIES OF HOME SCHOOLED
OR PRIVATE SCHOOLED STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES**



Local education agencies (LEAs, also referred to in Georgia as public school districts) have an obligation to locate and evaluate students with disabilities enrolled by their parents in private schools and home schools located within the district's boundaries, or those who are home-schooled. LEAs also must calculate and spend a proportionate share of federal special education (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act or IDEA) grant funds to provide equitable special education services for these students. These services could be therapy services, such as speech, occupational therapy or physical therapy, or equipment such as computers or iPads.

Whitfield County Schools will offer an informational meeting regarding services available.
