NORTHWEST GEORGIA COLLEGE & CAREER ACADEMY PARKING AGREEMENT

Driving a vehicle is a privilege that carries much responsibility. The contents of this agreement are for the safety of all people on the campus of NWGCCA as well as the student drivers.

To meet the requirements of driving on campus, all students must register their vehicles by:

1. Filling out this form.
2. Showing a valid driver's license.
3. Showing proof of current liability insurance.
4. Showing a valid tag number.

It shall be the responsibility of the student to:

Park within the designated areas. Lock car and do not leave valuables inside of car.
Observe all parking and driving regulations. Pay all fines or turn decals in to office for violations.

1st fine \$10.00, 2nd and all subsequent offences \$10.00 plus loss of driving privileges as determined by

Administration. Dangerous/reckless driving may result in a minimum of one month loss of driving privileges plus a \$10.00 fine.

PARKING AND DRIVING REGULATIONS

Any motor vehicle violation may be turned over to the proper law enforcement officials.

1. All cars must be properly parked in their designated area and inside parking spaces.
2. Any vehicle parked in the wrong area or with the wrong decal is subject to being towed at owner's expense without notice.
3. No parking on curbs, grass islands, in front of school, in rear of building or teachers parking lot.
4. Please exit the vehicle after it is parked.
5. Students are not allowed to return to vehicles between classes without written permission from an administrator.
6. Motorcycles must park in marked parking spaces and follow all other rules which apply to automobiles.
7. **All drivers must observe a maximum speed limit of 15 miles per hour.**
8. All vehicles are to remain on paved parking areas or driveways at all times.
9. Correct driving techniques and proper parking procedures must be observed at all times when vehicle is on campus. This includes excessive noise, reckless driving, speeding or any other action that may affect the safety, convenience or welfare of the students and staff of the Career Academy.
10. Student drivers must yield to school buses when leaving campus.
11. Motor vehicles registered to a student are not to be made available for the use of other students on the campus of the Career Academy.
12. All vehicles driven to the NWGCCA property are subject to search by school personnel.
13. All driving regulations are in effect 24 hours per day.
14. Failure to comply with the rules and regulations as established above will make the student driver subject to loss of driving privileges on the school campus for a period of up to one year or other disciplinary actions.
